**158/24 SOUTH WARWICKSHIRE LOCAL PLAN (SWLP):** Cllr Gosling reported he had attended the recent briefing session. The sessions are being held in preparation for the launch of the Preferred Options consultation in January. There will also be an opportunity to comment on the new local plan part 1 which will ultimately set out strategic planning policies about where and how new jobs, homes and infrastructure are all delivered in the context of place-shaping and addressing climate change.

**159/24 ROAD SAFETY ISSUES –**

**Southam Street, Warwick Road, King John's Road and Banbury Road**

Warwick Road – The school sign obscured by foliage is to be moved to the adjacent post.

Tysoe Road – To note there has been no further update received on the 30 mph speed signs nor the gateway. After discussion it was unanimously agreed to write to the Leader of the County Council and request the 10k put aside for the project be transferred to the Parish Council for Road Safety initiatives.

#### **160/24 CONSULTATION – STRATFORD-ON-AVON DISTRICT COUNCIL (PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION) (DOG FOULING) ORDER 2025**

Stratford District Council will shortly consider making a public spaces protection order, effective across the whole district, to prohibit people from failing to pick up after their dogs.

Public spaces protection orders are designed to tackle anti-social behaviour in public places. The behaviour which the Council is looking to prohibit has been identified as detrimental to the area, persistent and unreasonable.
